# **'COMMIT TO SOMETHING BETTER IN 2024'**

The year 2024 has arrived. What are you going to do with it? What new commitments are you going to make? What areas of your life do you plan on improving? As Christians, we can never answer these without thinking about our faith in, and walk with Jesus. Jesus wants us to be well-rounded followers. At Munholland, we put it this way: God wants us to Connect, Grow, Serve, and Lead in the name of Jesus Christ.

God wants us to **connect** with Him. Connecting with God refers to our personal time with God through Scriptural devotional times of prayer. Prayers of thanks, petition, requests for wisdom and guidance reveal God's will for our personal lives. Bible memorization, meditation, and fasting are other ways we can draw close to God. Connecting with God is also a corporate endeavor in times of worship. Most worship is during Sunday morning, but there are other worship times where we focus on praise, prayer, listening to God, and being shaped by God. Whenever and wherever we worship God, we are strengthening our connection with Him.

God wants us to **grow** together in Christ. God never intended for us to be Lone Ranger Christians. God wants us together as a family, a body, the temple of the Holy Spirit. Grow Groups help us practice the virtues of our faith with each other so that we can do so out in the world. They provide a place to be transparent, pray for each other, learn to practice the virtues of the faith, share what is going on in our lives, encourage each other, and be a strength for one another. Grow Groups include study but are not limited to that. Grow groups are transformational, not just informational. There is no more powerful way to Grow in Christ than in a group of committed, loving Christians.

God wants us to **serve** the world. Serving the world is indispensable to our faith. In both the Old Testament and the New, God tells His people to take care of the 'widow, orphan, and alien' in our midst. That is shorthand for saying we should care for anyone who is alone and without resources. In Matthew 18, Jesus talks about the day of judgement when the sheep and the goats are separated according to whether or not they helped the hungry, thirsty, naked, lonely, sick, and prisoners. As James puts it: Faith without works is dead. I will show you my faith by what I do. Service is putting faith into action.

# **'THE SPIRIT FILLED LIFE'**

The Holy Spirit, while part of the Holy Trinity with God the Father and Jesus the Son, remains a mysterious figure to us. We read in Scripture where the Spirit led Jesus to the wilderness to be tempted, or when the church was birthed, the Spirit came like tongues of fire! Jesus Himself said, that it is good that He should leave so the "Helper" the Holy Spirit could come to empower and remind them of everything He had taught them.

Who is the Holy Spirit and how does He work in our lives? Is He always with us, or do we need to pray to Him and ask Him to lead us? How then does He communicate with us?

Beginning January 31st for six weeks Tom Bergeon will lead us into a deeper understanding of the person and work of this third person of the Trinity, and will cover topics such as:

- 1. Who is the Holy Spirit and what are His roles in the Trinity?
- 2. Understanding the Power of the Spirit and how His role enables us to live a godly and fruitful life.
- 3. What does it mean to be filled by the Spirit and what are the gifts He gives.
- 4. What are the works of the Spirit?
- 5. Moment by moment walking by the Spirit, not quenching His presence.
- 6. Actively waiting on the Spirit, His timing, our receptiveness.
- 7.Living our lives in the power, presence, and purpose of the Holy Spirit and not in our own strength in the flesh.
- 8. Finding God's will for our lives by faithfully walking in the Spirit.

The focus of the course is walking in the Spirit. Developing insight to God's empowerment by recognizing our inadequacy and allowing the Holy Spirit to move in our lives making us joyful and more like Christ, in His timing and allowing us to reach others in God's strength with His presence and good news.


